Dear Mr. Teague:

In accordance with the provisions of the Deepwater Port Act of 1974 (DWPA), as amended, and by delegated authority from the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Transportation to the Maritime Administrator, this letter informs you of the approval, with conditions, of the SPOT Terminal Services LLC (SPOT) Deepwater Port License Application, submitted to the Maritime Administration (MARAD) on January 31, 2019. The rationale for this decision and the required conditions of approval are discussed in the enclosed Record of Decision (ROD) document, issued on November 21, 2022.

The ROD is not a license under the DWPA. The conditions described in the SPOT ROD must be addressed prior to the issuance of the deepwater port license. For this purpose, MARAD's Office of the Chief Counsel and Office of Deepwater Port Licensing and Port Conveyance are authorized to negotiate and execute the necessary documents to issue the deepwater port license.

MARAD will work with SPOT to address and satisfy the conditions of approval for the issuance of the License, as described in the enclosed SPOT ROD.
