Route Name: Alaska Coastal Waters

Sponsor: State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities

Route Designated: 2023

Landside Route Served: Alaska Route 11

Route Description: The M-11 Route aims to incorporate all navigable waterways and ocean channels for the transportation of goods, commodities, and services to, from, and across Southwestern and Northern Alaska. The route initiates at Unimak Pass in the Lake and Peninsula Borough, Aleutian Chain, and extends over 1,500 linear miles north along the coastline, ultimately concluding near the Canadian border at Kaktovik, AK. The M-11 Route completes a network of marine routes that encompass Alaska's commercially navigable coastal and intercoastal waterways, spanning 6,640 miles from British Columbia to the Gulf of Alaska, and northward to the Beaufort and Chukchi Seas merging into the Arctic Ocean.
