Route Description: The M-90 Route consists of the Great Lakes, Erie Canal, and connecting commercial navigation channels, ports, and harbors from Albany, NY, to Chicago, IL and Duluth, MN. It spans New York, Pennsylvania, Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Michigan, and Wisconsin. It connects to the M-75 Detroit/Windsor Crossing near Detroit, MI, and the M-71/77 Lake Erie Crossing near Cleveland, OH.
