

Landside Route Served: American Samoa is a United States Territory located in the Pacific Ocean, south of the equator and sits in the heart of Polynesia. Its harbor operations are in the South Pacific region as a hub for international trade and regional transshipment. Situated at 14 degrees 20' south latitude and 172 degrees 42' west longitude, it is the only U.S Territory below the equator and is made up of seven islands.

Route Description: This Marine Highway Route includes the waterways and ocean channels between islands of the territory of American Samoa, within the Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ). These Islands include" Tutuila, Aunuu, Ofu, Olosega, Ta'u, Swains and Rose Atoll.

Route Length: 230 Statute Miles
