

**Landside Route Served**: PAG and CPA applied collectively to designate the waterways currently used to transport all goods and commodities between Guam and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI) main islands of Rota, Tinian, and Saipan.

**Route Description:** PAG and CPA both service marine operations of containers, break-bulk, roll-on/roll-off (RORO) vessels, fishing vessels, fuel operations, and occasionally passenger vessels/cruise ships. The Marine Highway Route Designation supports the expansion of the already existent containerized freight service to the islands.

Route Length: 138 Statute Miles



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
