## Introduction

The Maritime Administration's (MARAD) mission is to foster, promote, and develop the maritime industry of the United States to meet the nation's economic and security needs. The National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for Fiscal Year 2023 (FY 2023) requires MARAD to conduct annual reviews of Federal agencies' administration of cargo preference programs and submit reports of these reviews to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure (T&I) in the House of Representatives and the Committee on Commerce, Science and Transportation (CST) in the Senate.

## **Summary**

Pursuant to 46 U.S.C. § 55305, Federal agencies are required to ship a minimum of 50% of their government-impelled cargo aboard U.S. flag vessels.<sup>1</sup> The Secretary is required to conduct an annual review of these agencies' compliance with § 55305(e)(2) and provide a report of such to the House T&I and the Senate CST Committees by the NDAA FY 2023 (now codified at 46 U.S.C. § 55305(e)(2)).

The report reflects the gross tonnage of cargo transported using U.S. flag and foreign vessels by each Federal agency and department as reflected by the bills of lading they or their contractors provided to MARAD in accordance with 46 CFR § 381.3. The report does not provide the actual total gross tonnage per agency/department because Federal agencies are not required to submit ocean shipment contracts or shipping plans to MARAD. Accordingly, MARAD cannot determine with certainty whether the 50% minimum has been met. With changes required by NDAA FY 2024, Federal agencies will provide MARAD with total gross tonnage of ocean cargo shipped and the gross tonnage shipped on U.S.-flagged and foreign-flagged vessels, annually, which is expected to improve cargo preference compliance reporting.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> 46 U.S.C. § 55305 states specifically that the 50% minimum cargo preference requirements apply when "the United States Government procures, contracts for, or otherwise obtains for its own account, or furnishes to or for the account of a foreign country, organization, or persons without provision for reimbursement, any equipment, materials, or commodities, or provides financing in any way with Federal funds for the account of any persons unless otherwise exempted...or advances funds or credits, or guarantees the convertibility of foreign currencies in connection with the furnishing or obtaining of the equipment, materials, or commodities." We use the term "government-impelled cargo" as a shorthand reference for this requirement.
